WHEREAS, the City of Dinuba recognizes the necessity of improving access to health services for migrant workers and their families in the State of California as well as in their place of origin; and


WHEREAS, bi-national collaboration on public health issues contributes to improving the quality of life of the people of both California and Mexico; and


