Binational Health Week (BHW) is one of the largest mobilization efforts of federal and state government agencies, community-based organizations, and volunteers in the Americas to improve the health and well-being of the underserved Latino population living in the United States and Canada. It encompasses an annual weeklong series of health promotion and health education activities that include workshops, insurance referrals, and medical screenings.

This year, the Seventeenth BHW will take place in **October 2017** in 40 states in the U.S. and 3 provinces in Canada, with the participation of the consulate networks in the United States of Mexico, Guatemala, Honduras, Colombia, Dominican Republic, Bolivia, Ecuador, and Peru. The inaugural event and Policy Forum on Migration and Health will be held on October in Mexico.
